Wednesday	L.I: I am learning how to sound out and spell 'ee' words Activity: complete 'ee' worksheet Learn 'ee' spelling words for spelling test on Friday. Please read a book of your choice for 10 minutes a day,	L.I: I am learning to recognise halves and quarters Activity- Fractions Revision This week we are going to being looking at splitting a whole object into smaller parts. When we have an object, we call it the whole, as it is one complete object. If we split it into 2 equal parts (remember that equal means the same)	L.I: I am learning to write a story about my Arctic animal Activity: Write about your Artic Animal	

		then we say it is in 2 halves. When we split the whole into 4 equal parts, we call each part a quarter. Have a look at the video to find out more. Once you've watched the video, you have a tasty task! Ask someone in your house to help you to make a sandwich or a slice of toast, this will be the whole. Then your job is to cut it into 2 equal parts (to make halves) and then into 4 equal parts to make quarters. If you want more practise, you could us a piece of paper and cut it up or you could draw a shape and try to split it into halves and quarters. Thursday	L.I: I am learning how to use a noun. Activity: "Nouns Hunt" A noun is a person, place or thing e.g. ball, chair, school, and then watch nouns PowerPoint. Afterwards go for a walk with a family member and see how many nouns you can see. Who is the winner of the noun hunt? Please read a book of your choice for 10 minutes a day,	L.I: I am learning to sort fractions of numbers Activity - Fractions of numbers Today we're going to look at finding fractions of numbers. This means getting some objects and seeing if you can share them fairly between different people. If you're sharing a number between 4 people, or into 4 different group, then you will be splitting them into quarters. If you are sharing then into 2 groups, you will be splitting them in halves and so on. Have a look at the video to remind yourself about sharing fairly. Then, I would like you to try and solve some problems! Can you find out what is a quarter of 24? (Remember, you'll need to share it into 4 groups.) How about half of 20? (Remember, you'll need to share it into 2 groups.) What other fractions of amounts can you find? Let me know how you get on. Remember to use the two times table with halves and the four times table with quarters. Activity: Rainbow Writing of spelling words Writing three sentences Complete any unfinished work	L.I: Activity - Division by sharing Last week we looked at fractions of shapes - sharing shapes into equal parts. Today we're going to start looking at sharing numbers into equal groups. A good example of this is shown in the picture. Someone had 6 cookies and they shared them equally between 2 friends. They took one cookie at a time, gave one to one friend, then one to the other friend and repeated this until all of the cookies were used up. In this way, they have made sure that each friend has the same amount of cookies, they have seem shared equally. Your job today is to practise sharing things equally. Maybe between the people in your house, or your toys?
