A POTATO is one of the easiest vegetables to use but you can let your imagination run wild.

- Make a book character from a potato (or other vegetables or fruit)
- Don't spend more than £2.50 making your vegetable
- You should keep your vegetable creation under 20cm x 20cm
- Fill in an entry form so the judges know who your character is
- Bring your character into school on Thursday 7th March for display in your class

If you don't want to make a vegetable character, do not worry. You can just enjoy the characters in your class or have fun guessing who they are!
