




Eco Sculpture - Picture Plan 11-05-20

Location - sculpture to be used to cover up a wall we don't like in our garden!

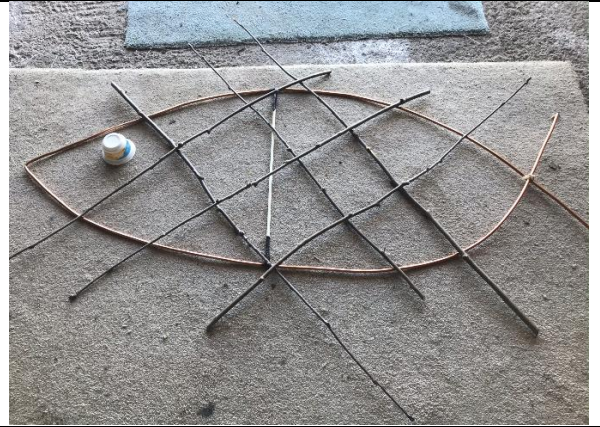
2. **Think** - We have decided to make our sculpture a fish. Using natural materials and plastic the sculpture will remind us to use LESS single use plastic.
