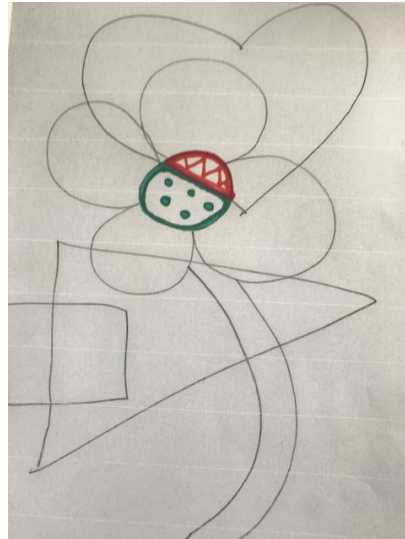

**Picture Plan**

**Abstract Art Project**

1. Draw 3 – 5 bold large shapes – flower, heart, triangle & rectangle – overlap the shapes to create smaller areas.
2. Choose 4 contrasting colours to colour each area – 2 “cool” colours such as blue and green and 2 “hot” colours such as red and orange.
3. Create your own patterns for each section (see below)

4. Try to colour neighbouring sections in opposite colour pairs...



5. Take your time, repeat some patterns if you like, but see how many different zig-zag lines, dots, swirls etc. you can come up with....
