Throughout the story, ask questions about what they think the land of Honalee might look like. What do the people look like? What sort of animals or creatures might the land have? Are there mountains, lakes and trees or are there deserts and caves? After going through the book use your imagination and design your own island of Honalee, marking each land mark eg desert, mountains, woods on the island. Colour in your drawing and add a key if there is time</p> <p>Activity – Make your own Honah Lee/Fairy Tale Land. This can be drawn first of all then made in 3d.
