Royal Highland Show Excursion

As an enhancement to the curriculum, we are planning a trip to Royal Highland Show on Friday 24th June 2022. This trip is open to S3-S6 pupils studying various courses in the Rural Skills, Home Economics and Business Education departments.

This trip is designed to allow pupils to see the various elements of the rural economy in practice and to offer a real-world experience which links to the outcomes of Developing the Young Workforce.

The Bus will leave school at 9am and return to the school by 5.30pm. As the return time is after the end of the school day, parents must arrange to collect pupils from school. Drop-offs can be arranged for pupils in Birnam, Logierait and Grandtully. If you would like for your child to be dropped off at one of these stops, please contact the school office to let them know. Otherwise, pupils will return to school for pick-up.

The cost for the pupils for this trip will be £12 - this will cover transport and entry to event and must be paid via ParentPay. We appreciate that the cost of some school trips can present families a financial challenge and we are keen to support pupils and their families but considering trip bursaries and payment plans where appropriate. If you would like to discuss financial assistance for this trip, please contact the school office and ask to speak to your child's guidance teacher. Please note that failure to pay for the trip on the terms agreed in advance of its departure may result in your child not being able to attend.

School uniform must be worn and bring with them a waterproof jacket. Pupils may wish to substitute their normal footwear for something appropriate for walking round the showground. Food will be available to purchase on the day from various vendors but can be expensive. Pupils are therefore welcome to bring packed lunches. If your child is in receipt of free School Meals, a packed lunch can be pre-ordered from Tayside Contracts the day before the trip and available to collect before departure. There are a number of stalls selling clothing, hot tubs, tractors etc.; pupils will have some free time during the day so they may want to bring some additional money (although they should think about the practicalities of getting any purchases home on the coach).
