S2 History Tour - Loch Tay, Kenmore & Weem, Myths & Legends, Famous Connections

All S2 pupils will be going on a local history tour courtesy of Taymouth Castle and the Breadalbane Heritage Society. Thanks to these organisations, this is a free trip for pupils to better understand their local history. Pupils will also be visited at school by local historians to explain the significance of this trip and outline what they will be doing.

The trip is running over two-days with 2FL going out on Wednesday 8th May and 2MS going out on Thursday 9th May.

The trip will depart at 9.15am and pupils are expected to wear school uniform (Taymouth suggested long trousers), suitable footwear and jacket. Pupils should bring a packed lunch and drink as they will be out of the school all day, returning at approximately 3.15pm. If your child is in receipt of Free School Meals, a packed lunch can be provided for the trip in place of the in-school lunch.
