

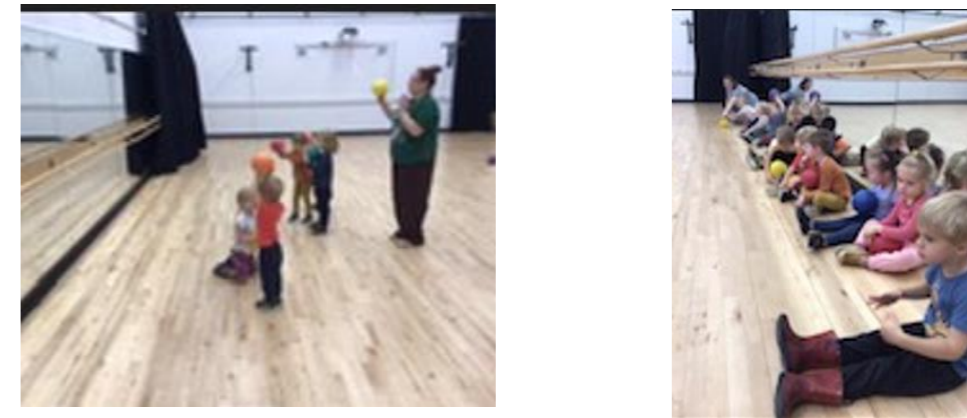
Letters, letters everywhere!
